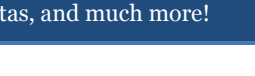
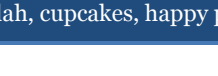

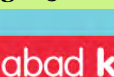
The "Mommy & Me" cooking class was great fun for Chabad's Little Chefs! They made pretzels, challah, cupcakes, happy pitas, and much more!
