



<u>Jacob</u> returns to the Holy Land after a 20-year stay in Charan, and sends angel-emissaries to <u>Esau</u> in hope of a reconciliation, but his messengers report that his brother is on the warpath with 400 armed men. Jacob prepares for <u>war</u>, <u>prays</u>, and sends Esau a large <u>gift</u> (consisting of hundreds of heads of livestock) to appease him.

Jacob and Esau meet, embrace and kiss, but part ways. Jacob purchases a plot of land near Shechem, whose crown prince—also called Shechem—abducts and rapes Jacob's daughter <u>Dinah</u>. Dinah's brothers <u>Simeon and Levi</u> avenge the deed by killing all male inhabitants of the city, after rendering them vulnerable by convincing them to circumcise themselves.

Our Parshah concludes with a detailed account of Esau's wives, children and grandchildren; the family histories of the people of <u>Seir</u>, among whom Esau settled; and a list of the <u>eight kings</u> who ruled Edom, the land of Esau's and Seir's descendants.
