Bringing three programs together (Friendship Circle, LifeTown, and Gan Menachem Preschool), the Friendship Garden will allow participants to produce healthy food for the Center, learn valuable gardening skills, environmental responsibility, and enjoy the variety of our natural world. Produce from the garden will be sold at the New Albany Farmer's Market to raise funds for Chabad programming, and will also be donated to soup kitchens and other organizations dedicated to feeding the hungry of Columbus.

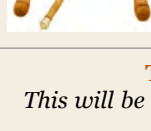

Please join us for "A Journey into the Soul of Torah", a weekly Torah study.

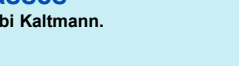
The class will continue on Thursdays at 7:30 pm at The Lori Schottenstein Chabad Center. Open to all and free of charge.

This will be an ongoing, monthly group and is open to all high school girls. Please contact Esther if you are interested.

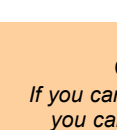
Introducing Tasty Torah

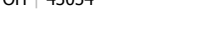
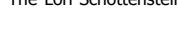
