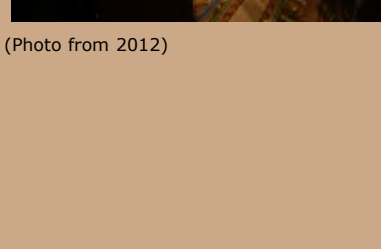

Upcoming special event - we encourage all ladies to attend the special Rosh Chodesh program during the National Jewish Retreat.

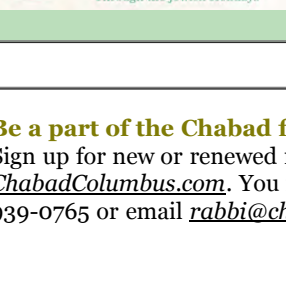
