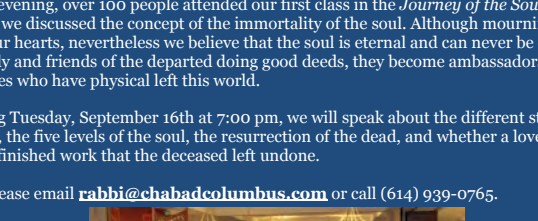

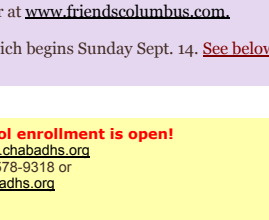
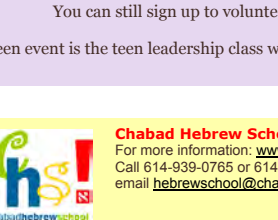


The Journey of the Soul has begun

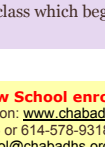
